Carter City Elementary is located in rural northeastern part of Carter County. The community of Carter City is rural with few businesses that serve the area. We have approximately 150 students including preschool enrolled this year. Our student population is somewhat transient with students moving in and out of the area. The school is about 70% free and reduced lunch with limited resources to pull from the community. Our staff includes nine full-time teachers, three half-time teachers, four part-time intinerant teachers (art, music, librarian, and counseling), one parttime speech therapist, three full-time instructional assistants, two part-time preschool instructional assistants, two cooks, and two custodians. We have a beautiful building that is nine years old and well maintained. The school has a lot of traditions that date back to the old school which was opened in the early 1940s. Many of the people that went to school there are now involved with the new school through their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. The entire school system is faced with the challenges of high poverty, drug abuse, broken homes, children being raised by grandparents, parents being incarcerated, and an increasing number of students who require special education services. Our school is no exception. We are fortunate that we have a low student-teacher ratio and are able to reach and know each child. In 2020 Carter City Elementary was recognized as a National Blue Ribbon School. We take a lot of pride in our school and continue to strive to be exceptional!
